Motorcyclists and Car drivers

In recent months we have suffered the loss of 2 motorcyclists (Fatals) and the serious injury of a third in collisions that were clearly avoidable.

Riders in all three cases had attempted to overtake traffic that was behind a vehicle turning right. Not unexpectedly, as the lead vehicle turned, the rider collided with it.

Signs and road markings were all in evidence that the junction was ahead. All the riders had a vast amount of experience but still chose to try and make the overtake.

Look at your behaviour on the road, look at your overtakes, are they risk assessed or just risky?

Car drivers please check your mirrors before turning right and signal your intention.



The last person you overtake will be the first witness at your crash scene!

There will be more fatals!
