March saw another Kingfisher, this time spotted by Lauren Wheeldon.

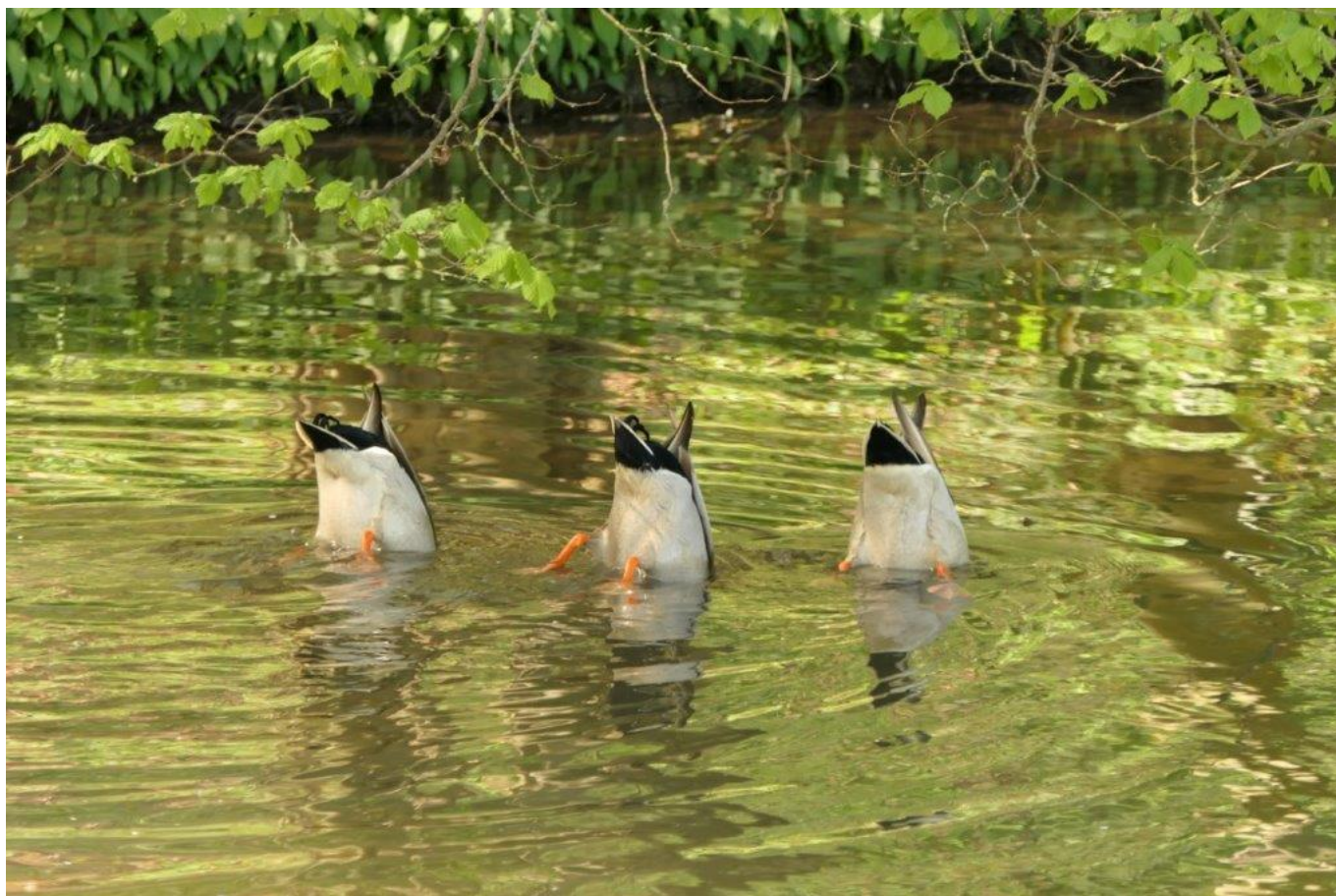


In April, we had some Roe Deer on the Derbyshire section, by Andrew Scott.
